Siouxland Human Investment Partnership (SHIP) is the Empowerment and Decategorization Board for Woodbury County, Iowa.

- Empowerment is a State of Iowa initiative that was established through legislation in 1998. The legislation allowed communities to form local governance boards to develop a community plan for early childhood. The focus of Empowerment is currently children ages 0-5.
- Decategorization (Decat) is a legislative initiative that allows unique planning and funding opportunities. SHIP has evolved to position itself as a collaborative board that is capable of administering initiatives involving Education, Health, Juvenile Justice and Human Services for pre-birth to death.

SHIP is a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation registered in Iowa. As Empowerment Area Coordinator, the SHIP organization is also a governmental entity established in Iowa Code 28.6(5).

VISION

Our community will provide opportunities for individuals and families to be healthy and resilient contributors to society.

MISSION

To provide leadership in response to identified community needs and collaboratively provide for the delivery of health, education, public safety and human services in Woodbury County.
